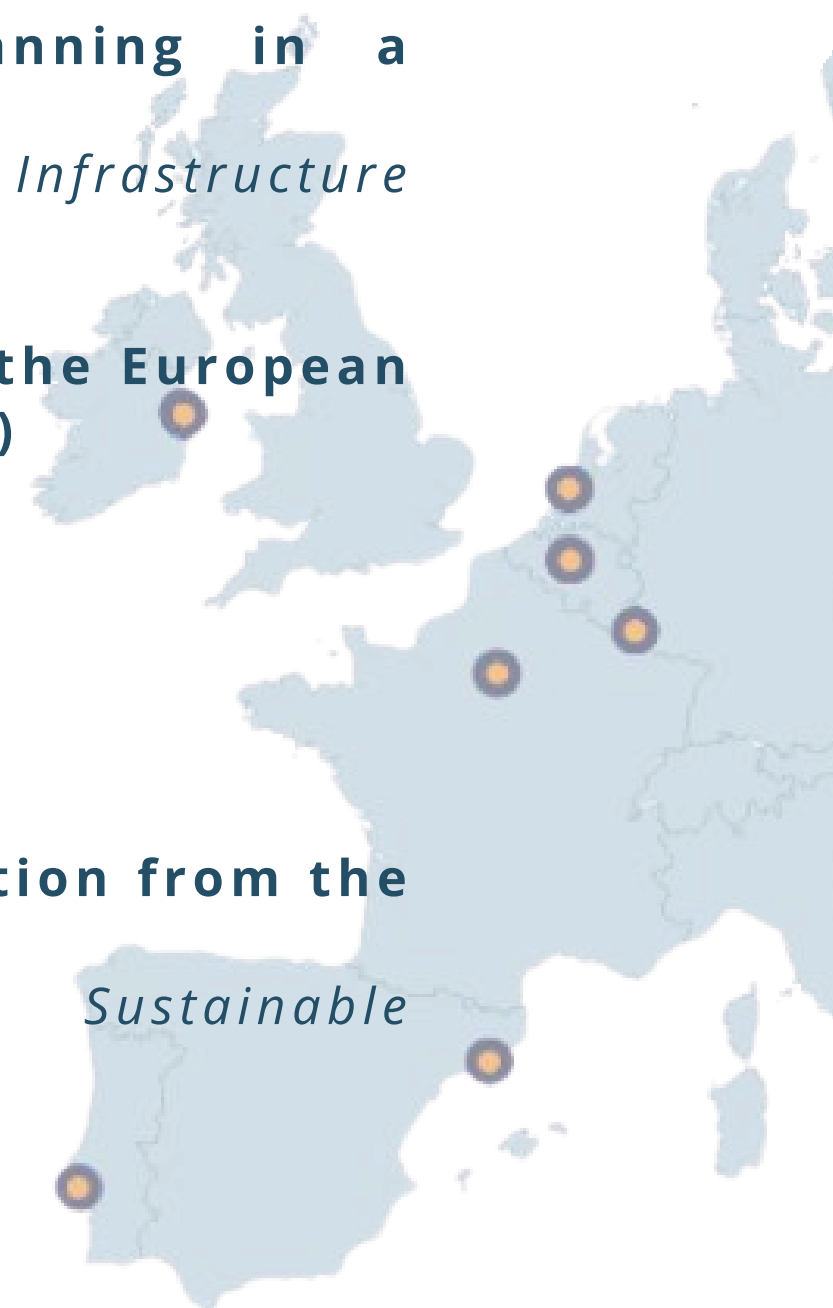
This session will dive deeper into adaptation policies, case studies, and financing mechanisms. We have three speakers with three different types of new insights into the topic.

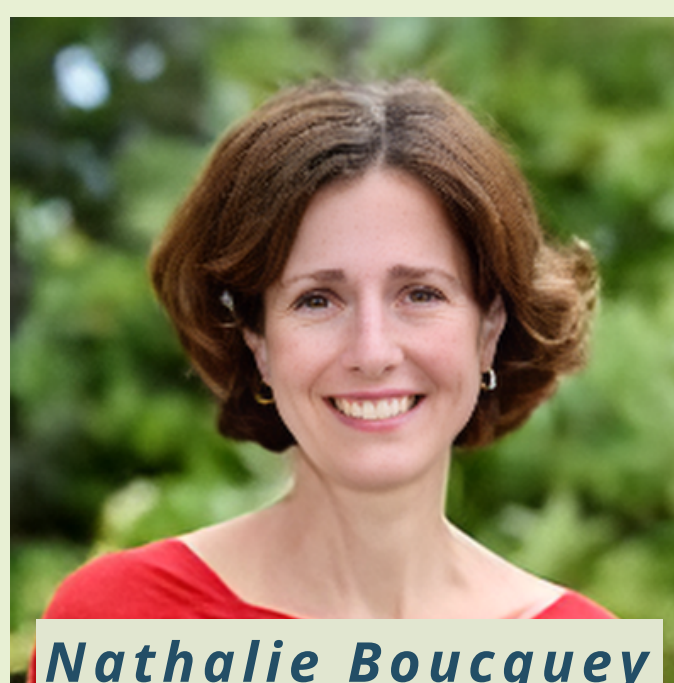
